Fall 2021 – Spring 2022

Students are having sex.

**71%**  
Have had oral sex

**69%**  
Have had vaginal sex

**23%**  
Have had anal sex

**45%**  
Rarely or never use a condom

**16%** | Have had 3-5 vaginal/anal sexual partners since August 2020

**64%** | Have NOT been STI tested within the last year

## What is Free Condom Friday (FCF)?

We provide a variety of free safer sex materials and sexual health education resources to reduce the risk of Sexually Transmitted Infections (STIs) and unintended pregnancies

- **Every Friday from 12-2pm** during the academic year in front of Campus Health
- Staffed by senior public health interns

External condoms



Internal condoms



Lube



Latex dams (flavored)



Gloves

Free Condom Friday makes students more likely to use a condom during sex.

**94%**



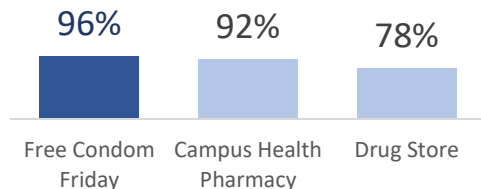
said that because of FCF, they were **more likely to use a condom**

**57%**



said they would be **less likely to use a condom** if FCF wasn't available

## Percent comfortable getting condoms at:



**96%**

said they **felt more comfortable** getting condoms at FCF than anywhere else

Students reported feeling most comfortable getting condoms from FCF
