
## **Get the Facts**

- Mpox (formerly monkeypox) causes temporary skin rashes that typically get better on their own, without treatment.
- The vast majority of cases are currently being spread through sex and intimate, skin-to-skin contact with an infected partner.
- Initial symptoms are flu-like.
- Signs/symptoms:
  - painful rash with bumps/blisters on the skin
  - fever
  - chills
  - exhaustion
  - headache
  - muscle aches
