- Staffed by senior public health interns

Free Condom Friday makes students more likely to use a condom during sex.

92%



said that because of FCF, they were more likely to use a condom 55%



said they would be less likely to use a condom if FCF wasn't available

Free Condom Friday is an effective marketing tool for **Campus Health and supports a** welcoming and non-judgmental environment.




Students use FCF for a variety of reasons, but mostly because it's free
