

Sexual Health Quick Look



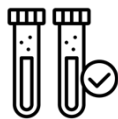
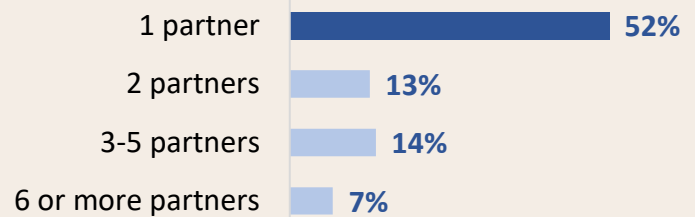
Health and Wellness Survey 2023 (N= 3872)

Key Insights:

- ✓ 65% of students have been **sexually active** in the past year.
- ✓ 25% of students reported **never** having **any type of sex**.
- ✓ 67% of students have **not been tested for sexually transmitted infections (STIs)** within the past year.
- ✓ 38% of students use **some form of birth control other than condoms**. Popular forms of birth control include oral contraceptive pills and intrauterine devices.

65% of students have been **sexually active since August 2022**

Number of sexual partners (among sexually active):



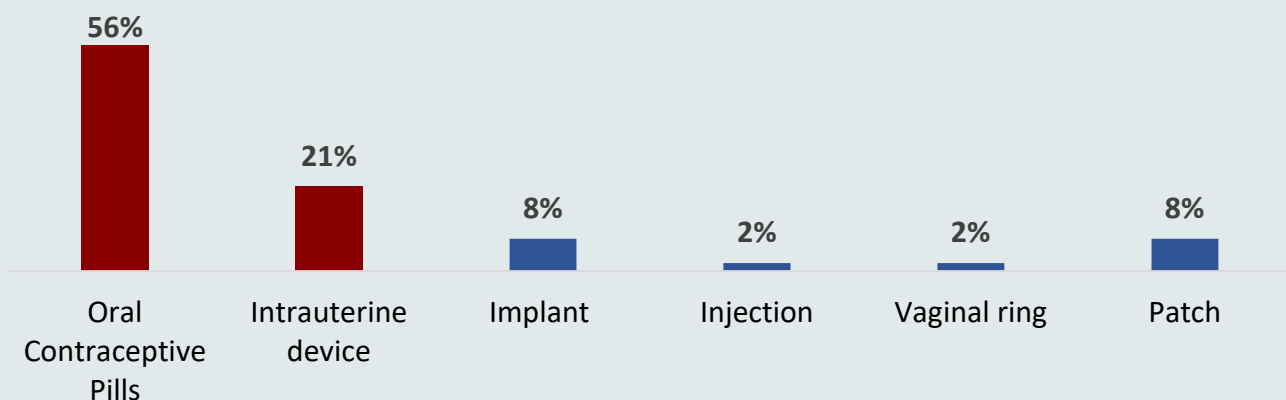
67% of students have **not been tested for STIs** within the last year (among sexually active)

48% of students know they can get **STI testing** at Campus Health **without it showing on their bursar account**



57% of students **usually or always** use a condom (among sexually active)
