
Health and Wellness Survey 2023 (N= 3872)

Key Insights:

- 65% of students have been sexually active in the past year.
- 25% of students reported never having any type of sex.
- 67% of students have not been tested for sexually transmitted infections (STIs) within the past year.
- ✓ 38% of students use some form of birth control other than condoms. Popular forms of birth control include oral contraceptive pills and intrauterine devices.

of students have not been tested for STIs within the last year (among sexually active)


