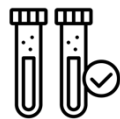
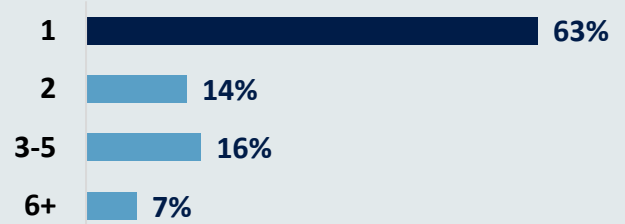
Undergraduate Health and Wellness Survey 2024 (N= 4,567)

Key Insights:

- ✓ 63% of students have been **sexually active** since August 2023.
- ✓ 31% of students reported **never** having any **type of sex**.
- ✓ 70% of students have **not been tested for sexually transmitted infections (STIs)** within the last year (among sexually active).
- ✓ 26% of students use **some form of birth control other than condoms**. Popular forms of birth control include oral contraceptive pills and intrauterine devices.
- ✓ 43% of **female identifying** students use a form of **hormonal birth control**.

63% of students have been **sexually active** since August 2023;
